Year 10 “Day to Work” – Summer 2024

The Year 10 Day to Work is a day where each student in Year 10 goes to work with a family member or another trusted adult. We see this as a valuable personal development opportunity for the students and an excellent introduction to our Careers Curriculum. The “Day to Work” helps students to appreciate the value of the skills they are learning in the classroom and boosts their confidence, practical and social skills. The Day to Work will be during the summer break.

We kindly ask that you discuss and work with your daughter and agree what they might do on the day. Students can undertake tasks that would be given to a junior employee and can “shadow” other workers. As the placement is only for a day, the student can be classed as a ‘visitor’ to the workplace to observe and take part in working practices that they would not normally come into contact with on a regular school day.
